One Talent, One Way to Share

Name one thing you are good at and one way you can give it back this week.

🕒 60 minutes · one session

🎯 WALK AWAY WITH

- Has named one thing he is good at out loud to the group.
- Has taught his talent to a partner for two minutes and learned what his partner is good at.
- Has run a three-station helper relay with a partner.
- Has written one way to share his talent this week on a card.

📦 BRING / SET UP

- A clear space to sit in a circle and walk in pairs
- A small ball, a soft pillow, and a roll of tape for the partner stations
- A pencil and a small card (or index card) for each Junior Saint to write on
- A few cones or chairs to mark the relay path
- A box at the front of the room to drop the cards into at the end

FOR THE LEADER

This is a Junior Saints preview of the **Consecration** badge. No advancement credit is earned here — the goal is to introduce these concepts to Junior Saints alongside the older Saints Global youth working the full BRC. The 4-session Saints Global arc lives under *Activity Plan (SG)* in the BRC builder.

ONE TALENT, ONE WAY TO SHARE (PAGE 1 OF 2)

THE HOUR

BLOCK 1 · DISCUSSION **Opener — Welcome circle**

⌚ 5 min

Stand in a circle. Each Junior Saint says his name. Then he names one thing he is good at. Examples: kicking a ball, drawing, listening, helping in the kitchen, being kind to a younger kid. The leader goes last. Keep each turn short.

BLOCK 2 · SKILL PRACTICE **Three jars sort**

⌚ 10 min

1. Sit on the floor. The leader names three pretend jars: KEEP, SHARE, GIVE.
2. The leader reads an example out loud. Each youth points to the jar it belongs in. Practice five times.
3. Examples to read: a brand-new toy you just got. A sandwich at lunch when a friend forgot his. A drawing of your dog. The change in your pocket. A song you know by heart.
4. Teaching point: some things we keep. Some we share. Some we give back. Today we work on the share jar.

BLOCK 3 · ROLEPLAY **Lend your talent**

⌚ 15 min

1. Pair up with a partner. Sit face to face.
2. Each youth tells his partner the one thing he is good at. Two short sentences.
3. For two minutes, the first partner teaches his talent. If you kick well, show your partner how you set your foot. If you listen well, listen to a short story.
4. Switch. The second partner teaches his talent for two minutes.
5. Sit in a circle when both have gone.
6. Each pair tells the group one thing they learned from each other.
7. Teaching point: a talent grows when you share it. It does not get smaller.

BLOCK 4 · PHYSICAL **The helper relay**

⌚ 15 min

1. Stay with your partner. Each pair runs the same short path.
2. Station 1: One partner carries a soft ball. Pass it to your partner without dropping. Walk to the cone.
3. Station 2: One partner balances a small pillow on his head. The other walks next to him to catch it if it falls.
4. Station 3: Tape a piece of tape from one cone to the next together. One holds, the other sticks.
5. No racing. The point is to help your partner, not to win.
6. Switch roles and run the path one more time.

ONE TALENT, ONE WAY TO SHARE (PAGE 2 OF 2)

THE HOUR — CONTINUED

BLOCK 5 · CREATIVE **Write one way to share**

⌚ 10 min

1. Sit down with a card and a pencil.
2. Write or draw one way you will share your talent this week. Keep it small and real.
3. Examples: "I will teach my little brother to kick a ball." "I will draw a picture for my grandma." "I will listen to my mom for ten minutes after dinner."
4. Each youth reads or shows what he wrote.
5. Drop your card in the box at the front. The leader keeps the box for next time.

BLOCK 6 · REFLECTION **Close — Tell and cheer**

⌚ 5 min

1. Stand in a circle. Stretch your arms up, then down to your toes. Hold each for 10 seconds.
2. Drink water.
3. Each Junior Saint says: 'This week I will ____.' Just the one way to share from his card.
4. Group cheer: 'Share what you have!' Three times.
5. Homework: do the share thing this week. Tell your parent or guardian what you did.

AT THE CLOSE · DEBRIEF

1. What was your partner good at that you did not know before?
2. Which jar did you point to most in the sort game?
3. What one way to share did you write on your card?

Print and post so Junior Saints see the keep, share, and give-back jars.

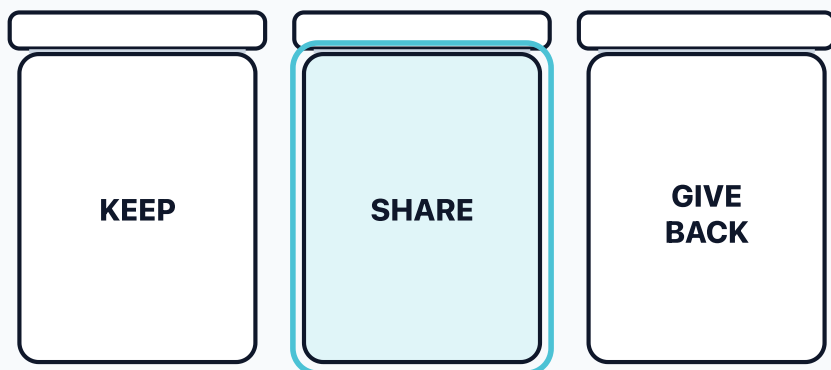
CONSECRATION · JUNIOR SAINTS CARD
